## Respect Code of Conduct

**Spectators and Parents/ Carers:**

- We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behavior in the game.
- This club is supporting The FA's Respect programme to ensure football can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment.
- Remember children's football is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills. Winning isn't everything.
- Play your part and observe the FA's Respect Code of Conduct for spectators and parents/ carers at all times.

➤ **I will:**

- Remember that children play for fun.
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success.
- Always respect the match officials' decision.
- Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided).
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do.
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials.
- Avoid criticizing a player for making a mistake – mistakes are part of learning.
- Never engage in, tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behavior.

➤ **I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/ all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA, league or The FA:**

➤ **I may be:**

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official.
- We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behavior in the game.
- Required to meet with the club committee.
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course.
- Requested by the club not to attend future games.
- Suspended or have my club membership removed.
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents.

➤ **In addition:**

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/ or suspension on the club.
